- 1. The Park Office is open 7 days Phone: 9527 1297.
- 2. After Hours Emergency Assistance from Park Management (Emergencies Only) Phone: 0407 515 575.
- 3. Emergency Evacuation: In the event of an emergency evacuation of the Park, please meet at a nominated muster point as signposted and indicated on your site map (Governor Rd at Park entry and corner Governor Rd and Rockingham Beach Road near phone box).
- 4. Fire hose reels are located throughout the Park for emergencies only. Please refer to your site map to identify locations.
- 5. Check out time is 10am
- 6. Speed limit for all modes of transport (vehicles, e-bikes, e-scooters etc.) is strictly 8km/hour maximum to ensure the safety of all guests, residents, visitors, and staff. Please follow the traffic flow arrows on all Park roads as indicated on your site map.
- 7. Please ensure visitors park in the Visitors Car Park or on the grass verge located on Governor Road.
- 8. RV Sites: One vehicle per site to accompany your RV.
- 9. Chalet Sites: One vehicle per site. Vehicles can be parked alongside your chalet.
- 10. Please keep noise to a minimum between the hours of 10pm and 7am daily.
- 11. Guests are responsible for the behaviour of their visitors while on site.
- 12. Guests are responsible for any damages incurred by themselves or their guests.
- 13. Guests are responsible for keeping valuables, vehicles etc. secure at all times. Management accepts no responsibility for the theft or damage to any property brought into the Park by any person.
- 14. Abusive or threatening language and behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstance and may result in the immediate cancellation of your stay.
- 15. Replacement keys, amenities fobs and boom gate remotes will be charged to the guest if lost/taken.
- 16. General household waste only to be disposed of in the bins provided.
- 17. Parents are responsible for the conduct and supervision of their children and for their safety. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult to the amenities (e.g. ablutions, laundries, recreation room). Parents must supervise children on bikes/scooters and traffic flow/speed restrictions must be adhered to at all times.
- 18. For the security of all guests and residents, please keep ablution, laundry and recreation room doors closed at all times.
- 19. Smoking is not permitted in any indoor areas of the park (e.g. ablutions, laundries, recreation room, office, chalets) or in public areas (e.g. playground, barbecue areas).
